Freshmen Year (9th Grade)

*Each class is offered for the entire school year (Term 1 and Term 2). If the student successfully passes the term then they will earn 1 credit for each class. **Except** for Physical Education (PE) in which each term is 0.58 credits and Health Education which is only taken for 1 term and results in 1 credit.

Mathematics

Algebra Term 1 - MES21/Term2 - MES22 (2 credits)
or Geometry Term1 - MGS21/Term2 - MGS22 (if algebra is taken with a passed regents exam in 8th grade)

Science

Living Environment Term1 - SLS21/Term2 - SLS22 (2 credits)
or Earth Science Term1 - SES21/Term2 - SES22 (if living environment is taken with a passed regents exam in 8th grade)

World Language

- Spanish Level I Term1 FSS61/Term2 FSS62 (2 credits)
- French Level I Term1 FFS61/Term2 FFS62 (2 credits)

<u>Arts</u>

- 2 Art periods (Dance, Visual Arts, Drama, Vocal, Instrumental)

- Physical Education PPS71 (.58 credits)
- Health PHS11 (1 credit) (students switch between PHYS ED and HEALTH Term1 and Term2)

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Sophomore Year (10th Grade)

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<u>English</u>

- English 10 Term 1 EES83/Term2 EES84 (2 credits) (Prerequisite- English 9)
- **or** AP Seminar Term1 EES41X/Term2 EES42X (2 credits weighted)
- **or** AP English Literature Term2 EES83X/Term2 EES84X (2 credits weighted)

*AP courses require application and approval

Social Studies

- Global History Year 2 Term1 HGS43/Term2 HGS44 (2 credits) (*Prerequisite-Global History Year 1*)
- **or** AP World History Term1 HGS43x/Term2 HGS44X (2 credits weighted) (*Prerequisite-Global History Year 1*)
- or US History Term1 HUS21/Term2 HUS22 (2 credits)
- (Prerequisite-Global History)
- **or** AP US History Term1 HUS21x/Term2 HUS22X (2 credits weighted)

*AP courses require application and approval

Mathematics

- Algebra I MES21 (this only applies to transfer students who didn't take course in 9th grade)
- Geometry Term1 MGS21/Term2 MGS22 (2 credits) (*Prerequisite-Algebra 1*)
- **or** Algebra II/Trigonometry Term2 MRS21/Term2 MRS22 (2 credits) (*Prerequisite- Geometry and Algebra I*)

Science

- Living Environment SLS21 (2 credits) ((this only applies to transfer students who didn't take course in 9th grade)
- Earth Science Term1 SES21/Term2 SES22 (2 credits) (*Prerequisite- Living Environment*)
- **or** Chemistry Term1 SCS21/Term2 SCS22 (2 credits) (*Prerequisite- Earth Science*)
- **or** Introduction to Environmental Geology Term1 SDS21/Term2 SDS22 (2 credits) (*Prerequisite- Earth Science, Chemistry*)



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World Language

- Your choice of language from 9th grade:

Spanish Level II Term1 - FSS63/Term2 - FSS64 (2 credits) French Level II Term1 - FFS63/Term2 - FFS64 (2 credits) (*Prerequisite- Level I in the selected language course; i.e. Spanish 1, or Mandarin I, or French I*) *Students need 3 years in the same language course to be eligible for the Advanced Regent diploma.

<u>Arts</u>

- Varies depending on your arts major (Dance, Visual Arts, Drama, Vocal, Instrumental)
- Student will have 2 periods of their arts major each day

- Health Education PHS11 (1 credit)- (you will only need to take this class if you didn't already complete it in the 9th-grade)
- Physical Education Term1 PPS72/Term2 PPS73 (0.58 per term)-Students will have a PE course each term through their high school career



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Junior Year (11th Grade)

*Each class is offered for the entire school year (Term 1 and Term 2). If the student successfully passes the term then they will earn 1 credit for each class. **Except** for Physical Education (PE) in which each term is 0.58 credits and Health Education which is only taken for 1 term and results in 1 credit.

<u>English</u>

- English 11 Term1 EES85/Term2 EES86 (2 credits)
- **or** AP Seminar Term1 EES41X/Term2 EES42X (2 credits weighted)
- **or** AP Research Term1 EES43X/Term2 EES44X (2 credits weighted) (*Prerequisite AP Seminar*)
- or AP English Literature Term1 EES83X/Term2 EES83X (2 credits weighted)
- or AP English Language Term1 EES85X/Term2 EES86X (2 credits weighted)
- **or** Film Studies Term 1 (2 credits weighted)

*AP and Film courses require application and approval

Social Studies

- US History Term1 HUS21/Term2 HUS22 (2 credits)
- **or** AP US History Term1 HUS21XTerm2 HUS22x (2 credits weighted)
- or AP Human Geography Term1 HPS21X/Term2 HPS22X (2 credits weighted) (elective)

(Prerequisite - US History)

*AP courses require application and approval

Mathematics

- Algebra II/Trigonometry Term2 MRS21/Term2 MRS22 (2 credits) (*Prerequisite- Geometry and Algebra I*)
- or Finance Math Term1 MQS81/Term2- MQS82 (2 credits) (elective)
- or Precalculus Term1 MPS21/Term2 MPS22 (2 credits) (Prerequisite - Alg II/Trigonometry2)
- or Computer Science Term1 MKS21/Term2 MKS22 (2 credits) (elective)
- or AP Computer Science Term1 MKS21X/Term2 MKS2X (2 credits weighted)(elective)



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Science

- Chemistry Term1 SCS21/Term2 SCS22(2 credits) (*Prerequisite- Living Environment - Earth Science*)
- **or** Introduction to Environmental Geology Term1 SDS21/Term2 SDS22 (2 credits) (*Prerequisite-Living Environment, Earth Science, Chemistry*)
- **or** AP Biology Term1 SBS21X/Term2 SBS22X(2 credits weighted) (*Prerequisite - Living Environment, Chemistry*)

*AP courses require application and approval

<u>World Language</u>

 Your choice of language from 9th grade: Spanish Level III Term1 - FSS65/Term2 - FSS66 (2 credits)
French Level III Term1 - FFS65/Term2 - FFS66 (2 credits)
(Prerequisite- Level II in the selected language course; i.e. Spanish 2, or Mandarin 2, or French 2)
*Students need 3 years in the same language course to be eligible for the Advanced Regent diploma.

- Personal Finance Term1 - RZS21/Term2 - RZS22 (2 credits)

<u>Arts</u>

<u>Senior Year (12th Grade)</u>

*Each class is offered for the entire school year (Term 1 and Term 2). If the student successfully passes the term then they will earn 1 credit for each class. **Except** for Physical Education (PE) in which each term is 0.58 credits and Health Education which is only taken for 1 term and results in 1 credit. Senior year works a bit different as students may have to retake courses required for graduation if they haven't earned credit for them.

<u>English</u>

-English 12 Term1 - EES87/Term2 - EES88 (2 credits)

- or Film Studies Term 3 - (2 credits weighted)

Social Studies

- Economics Term1 HES11 (1 credit)
- Participation in Government HVS11 (1 credit) Students switch between HES11 and HVS11 between Term1 and Term2

Mathematics (2 credits)

- Calculus Term1 MCS21/Term2 MCS22 (2 credits)
- Precalculus Term1 MPS21/Term2 MPS22 (2 credits) (Prerequisite - Alg II/Trigonometry2)
- Higher level math courses (must have passed Algebra and Geometry in the prior years)

Science (2 credits)

-Life Science or Physical Science (must have taken 1 year of Life and 1 year of Physical Science already)

World Language

- Seniors on track for the advanced regents diploma will complete their 3rd year of language
- Spanish Level III Term1 FSS65/Term2 FSS66 (2 credits)
- Mandarin Level III Term1 FMS65/Term2 FMS66 (2 credits)
- French Level III Term1 FFS65/Term2 FFS66 (2 credits) (Prerequisite- Level II in the selected language course; i.e. Spanish 2, or Mandarin 2, or French 2)

<u>Arts</u>

- 2 Art periods (Dance, Visual Arts, Drama, Vocal, Instrumental)

- Physical Education Term1 PPS76/Term2 PPS77 (0.58 credits each term)
- Health PHS11 (1 credit) (only if a student hasn't passed this course thus far)
